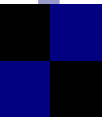

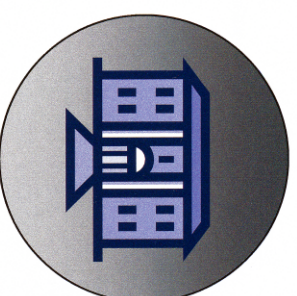

Reciprocal Borrowing

Program

In order to promote, enhance, and facilitate research, teaching, and learning in Indiana academic institutions, the Academic Libraries of Indiana (ALL) have established this reciprocal borrowing program.

Institutions that provide borrowing privileges via this program are listed below. The program applies to the main and branch libraries of the larger research institutions. Participating campuses and professional libraries are listed separately.

How to Participate

The home library authorizes a borrower to participate in the program by issuing a signed ALL Borrowers Card. Currently employed faculty and staff and currently enrolled students in good standing are eligible. The home library has final authority to issue or deny this privilege.

The home library determines the expiration date. The date may vary depending on the status of the borrower. Privileges are granted for up to one year, but expiring on or before June 30.

The borrower takes the ALL Borrowers Card, campus identification, and a photo ID with a current address to a participating library. Some lending libraries may issue a local library card. The ALL Borrowers Card should be presented at each visit.

Privileges and loan periods are determined by the lending (host) library and may vary from the borrower's home institution.

Borrower

Responsibilities

- Present the ALL Borrowers Card and other ID requested by the lending library for each visit.
- Observe the rules and regulations of the lending library.
- Return materials safely and in a timely manner. Return of materials via the home library interlibrary loan service may be possible, but borrowers are responsible for any overdue charges if they occur.
- Pay all fees, fines, and other financial obligations incurred.
- Return recalled materials immediately and/or by priority or express mail.
- Supply accurate mailing address and keep it current.
